- Section 1 The application to the Local Finance Board is hereby approved, and the attorney, along with other representatives of the fire district, are hereby authorized to prepare such application and to represent the fire district in matters pertaining thereto.
- Section 2 The Clerk and Qualified Purchasing Agent of the fire district is hereby directed to prepare and file a copy of the proposed application with the Local Finance Board as part of such application.
- Section 3 The Local Finance Board is hereby respectfully requested to consider such application and to record its findings, recommendations and/or approvals as provided by the applicable New Jersey Statute.
